As an applicant for the **ICAEW (also known as ACA)** or **ACCA** trainee programme we would expect you to be a graduate with a minimum 2:1 degree.

- Ability to work well in a team environment.
- Self motivated, hard working, flexible and prepared to undertake some travel.
- Ambitious with drive and resilience.
- Enthusiasm with a keen interest in learning and professional development.
- Excellent analytical skills with an eye for detail.
